I. JOB SUMMARY

Under the supervision of the Owner/President and the Project Engineer, the CAD Designer performs a variety of design/drafting activities including preparation of engineering plans, preparation of calculations, as well as perform other duties as requested, directed, or assigned. Occasional assistance with survey field work or construction observation may also be required.

- Performs plan drafting using AutoCAD and Civil3D software.
